## Weber County 4-H Scholarship

The Commitment to Agriculture Foundation is excited to offer our first scholarship for Weber County 4-H members graduating from High School in 2010. The results of our fundraiser and number of applicants will dictate the amount and number of scholarships awarded. Those awarded with scholarships will have up to 2 years to claim their funds unless they are granted an extension by the CTA Board of Directors.

The eligibility requirements for this scholarship are as follows:

- US Citizen
- GPA Exceeding 2.0
- Weber County Resident
- Weber County 4-H Member in Good Standing in any Project Area
- Senior in High School Graduating in 2010

The Application Process:

- Create an application packet to include the following items:
  - Application completely filled out including signatures (available at the extension office or online starting December 15, 2009 at [www.utahcta.org](http://www.utahcta.org) or [www.webercounty4-H.org](http://www.webercounty4-H.org))
  - 4-H Portfolio from 2009
  - Two Letters of Recommendation (One may be from a teacher but one must be from a community member.)
  - Certified Transcript from your High School.
- Mail the application to Melisa Griffith, Commitment to Agriculture Foundation, PO Box 1042, Eden, UT 84310. Must be postmarked by February 1, 2010
- Attend an interview in March 2010 – date to be announced.

Portfolio	15
Interview	15
Essay	10
Application Packet	5

Scholarship winners will be notified in writing in April of 2010. They will receive recognition at their High School Scholarship Awards Announcements and at the 4-H Awards night in November of 2010.
