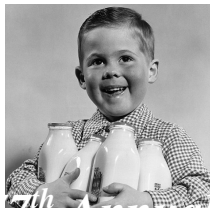

## RULES

- ★ No Health Certificates are required on instate cattle; however, a State Veterinarian will walk through the barns and animals identified with a communicable disease could be dismissed from the show.
- ◆ **Entry Fee:** \$10/animal is required and must be submitted at check-in.
- ◆ Animals can arrive no earlier than 3:00 p.m., Wednesday, April 13, 2011.
- ◆ Stall location is on a first-come basis.
- ◆ Registration Certificates must be presented prior to show time and only animals under 6 months of age will be accepted with papers applied for (except ET calves under 9 months).
- ◆ All animals must be available for the Junior Division Dairy Judging Contest.
- ◆ No exhibitor shall be paid more than *two* premiums per class or *one* premium per group class.
- ◆ Exhibitors shall provide their own feed for animals.
- ◆ *First bedding of sawdust will be provided.* Additional sawdust can be purchased at IFA or Cal Ranch in Ogden. (No straw allowed). (Please keep garbage out of bedding.)

**Red & White Holsteins** will be recognized. The highest placing Red & White in each respective class will be recognized. Champion Red & White animals will be selected prior to the selection of the champions of the regular show.
