Your service record should reflect service completed during the current 4-H year (October 1 through September 30); you may also include promotional activities during National 4-H week, which is the first full week of October. Turn in your completed service record on or before **October 15**, along with your county ambassador project summary. At the end of your term as County Ambassador, you will be honored at 4-H Achievement Night based upon the following criteria:

- Bronze County Ambassador: 50-74 points earned
- Silver County Ambassador: 75-149 points earned
- Gold County Ambassador: 150 or more points earned

\*\* Youth who fail to earn at least 50 points will not have fulfilled the minimum standards and will not be allowed to report their County Ambassador title in portfolio records, scholarship applications, etc.

However, you could give yourself credit on your Jr. Livestock form for participation in the Livestock Bowl contest and credit on your 4-H Ambassador form for participation in the 4-H Public Speaking contest.
